

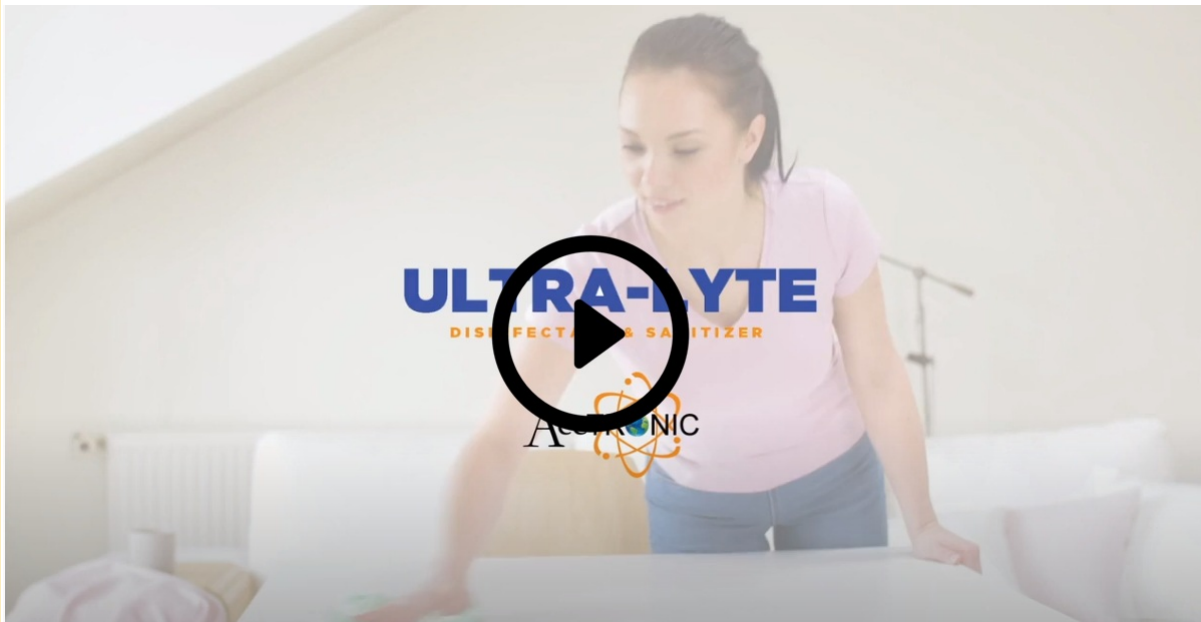

Disinfect & Sanitize Hard Surfaces



It is not yet known how long the virus causing COVID-19 lives on surfaces, however, early evidence suggests it can **live on objects and surfaces from a few hours to days.**

Surfaces frequently touched with hands are most likely to be contaminated. These touch-points include doorknobs, handrails, elevator buttons, light switches, cabinet handles, faucet handles, tables, counter-tops and electronics (cellphones, office equipment).

For this reason, you need to routinely clean and disinfect all hard-surfaces in combination with personal hand hygiene. Hand sanitizers alone will not decrease the spread of the virus. Therefore, in addition to hand sanitizers, use a DIN approved disinfectant on all touch-points to ensure hard-surfaces are disinfected/sanitized.
